As can be seen in the image, School Chaplains have many conversations with more than just students. They will often speak with parents/carers, family members & staff as well, about many varied topics, including covid, friendship difficulties, bullying, anxiety, school behaviour & family breakdown.

Chaplains have an average of:


- 15, 454 pastoral conversations with students
- 6, 114 pastoral conversations with school staff
- 3, 117 pastoral conversations with parents/carers

Of these conversations, 15% of students, 21% of school staff and 16% of parents/carers discussed covid & the impacts of it on theirs lives.
