This funding will be used to

- Increase the number of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving National Minimum Standard in Reading to 95%.
- Increase the number of Year 3 students and Year 5 students achieving Upper 2 Bands in Reading to 40%.
- Increase the number of students achieving National Minimum Standard in Year 5 Writing to 90%.
- Increase the number of students achieving grade C or higher in English to 88% and in Mathematics to 92%.
- Increase the number of Students With Disability achieving C or better in English and Mathematics to 70%.

Our initiatives include

- Enusuring all students, including those with disability, are supported with appropriate adjustments so that they can access all subjects in the Austrlian Curriculum.
- Introducing an evidenced-based Synthetic Phonics teaching sequence (Little Learners Love Literacy) in Prep and Year 1.
- Providing appropriate intervention for Prep students in reading and writing from early in the year.
- Providing teachers with additional opportunities to collaborate in a case-management approach so that deeper understanding of each student's instructional needs is enhanced.
- Providing additional opportunities to engage with the Head of Curriculum and other specialist teachers to build capacity in classroom teachers to differentiate teaching and assessement more effectively across the Australian Curriculum.
- Providing professional development in the evidenced-based '6+1 Traits of Writing' framework.
